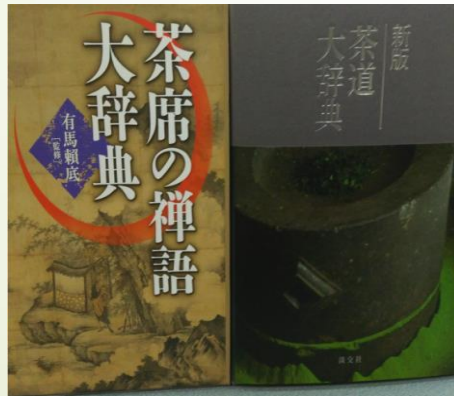

 - Library will allocate certain amount of fund for faculty for their teaching and research

Working for Departments and Faculty: Example

- FSU Departments of History, Religion, and Modern Languages proposing a new Program of Master of Arts in East Asian Studies
- Need price quotes for East Asian resources in print and online in their Proposal
- Searched and consulted Chinese vendors
- Consulted CEAL colleagues from UF, U of Pittsburgh, UC Berkeley, Kentucky Univ., and Princeton Univ.

Price Quotes for East Asian Resources

Digital subscriptions and digital databases

- 1. **Gujin tushu jicheng** 古今圖書集成 (the complete Chinese Classics collection) 808 volumes
<http://ctext.org/library.pl?if=gb&res=81155>
- 2. **Du Xiu** 读秀 (about \$5000 /year) 4.3 millions of Chinese books
- 3. **Chinamaxx Digital Libraries (Chaoxiing)** 超星电子图书 about \$5000 /year
(Univ. of Pittsburgh) buy title by title. Each title, \$10, plus \$500 annual maintenance fee.
- 4. **Dissertations of China (Full-text database of Chinese Doctoral Dissertations)**
- 5. **Japan Knowledge** (Japan's largest corpus of encyclopedia, dictionaries, reference compilations, and periodical resources)
- 6. **JapanKnowledge and MagazinePlus** (Japan's largest database of periodicals and academic articles)
